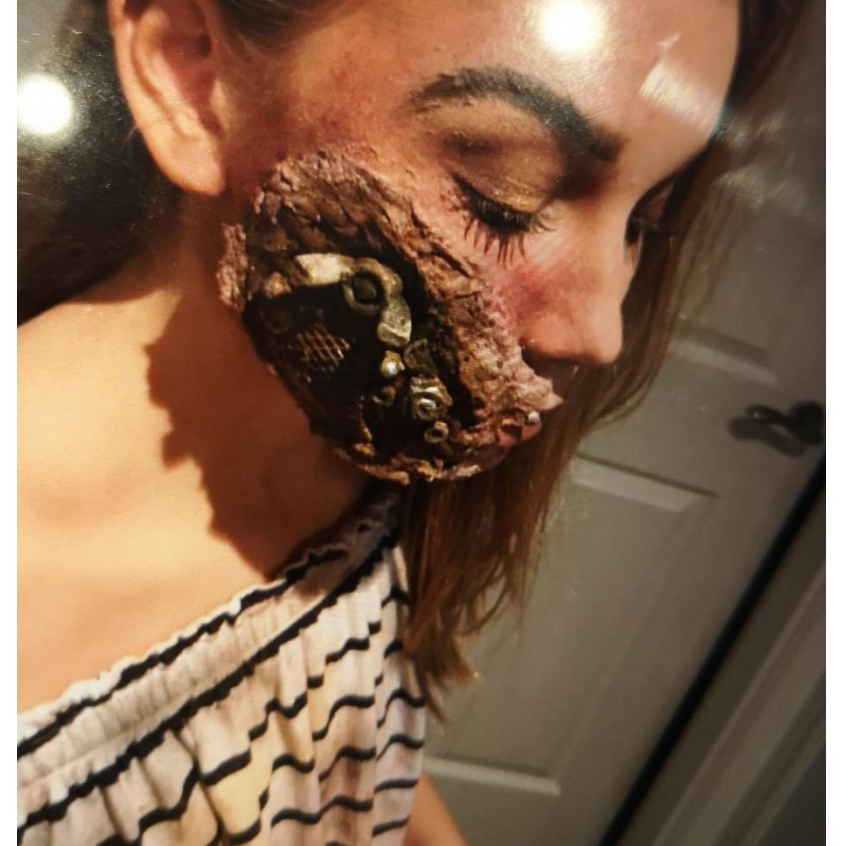

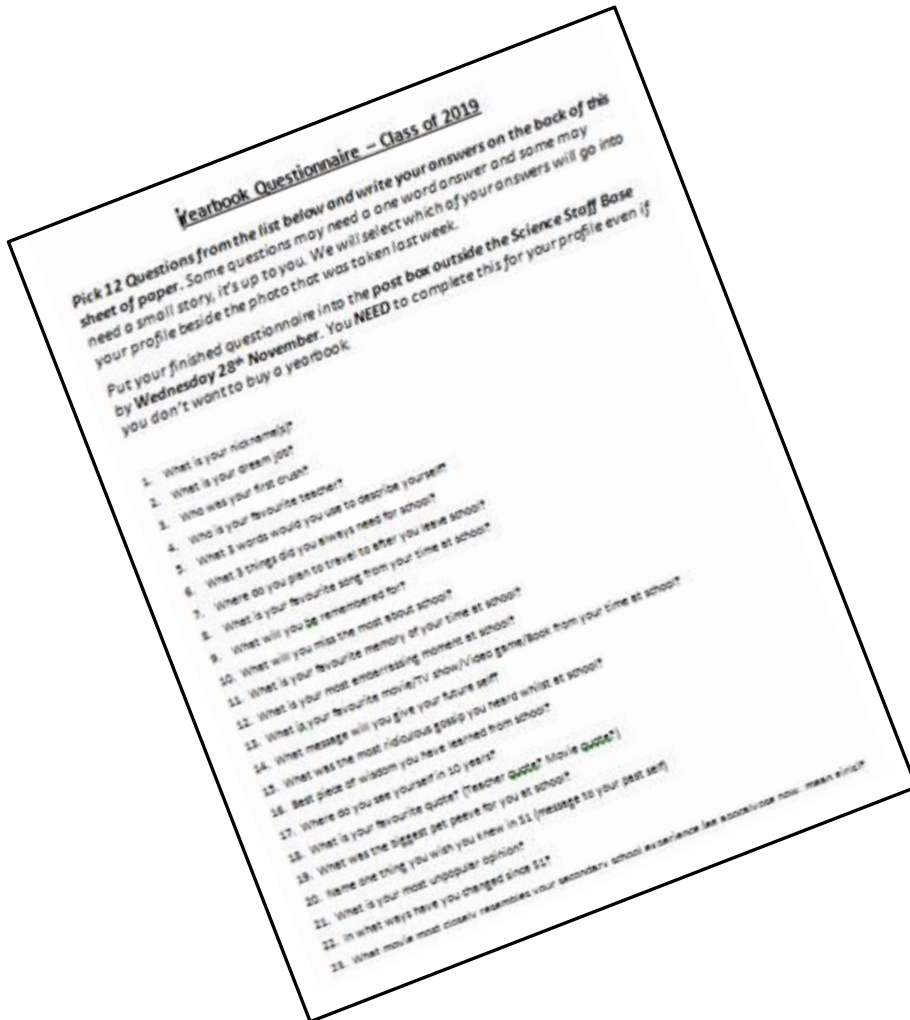
# S1 GRAPHIC NOVEL CLUB
