There is still time to sign up to receive your results by text.


School will be open on results day from 9-12 if you wish to pop in and talk about your results.

An average of 50 people drown in Scotland each year. Outdoor bodies of water such as lakes, rivers, canals, reservoirs and quarries are dangerous!

Do not jump or dive into open water. Quick entry into cold water can cause your body to go into shock, significantly increasing the risk of drowning.
