Good luck to all the seniors sitting prelims over the next two weeks. Here are some details to bear in mind:

- Please arrive for your exam at least ten minutes early.
- Your seat number will be displayed on posters in The Street.
- When the invigilator invites you into the hall, leave your bag at the side – don't take it to your desk.
- No pencil cases are allowed at desks.



- It is vital that your phone is properly switched off not just on silent because that doesn't prevent alarms from going off.
- Do not keep your phone in your pocket it is not allowed at your desk – so leave it in your bag at the side, or with a person you trust, or don't bring it to school on exam days.
- If you are caught with your phone at your desk (including switched off in your pocket) your exam may be disqualified. This is a firm SQA rule, not a Grange one!
- The above rules also apply for any other technology such as smart watches and ear pods.



- When you have finished a prelim, it is forbidden to loiter in The Street – you must go back to your normal class please. This is especially important at Annanhill Primary lunchtimes.
- For the fortnight of the prelim diet, you must follow your normal timetable but you are allowed to do private study in class. If you bring nothing to study, you will be expected to do the work of the subject.
- Normal uniform rules apply during prelims on a three-school campus at a time when normal routines are disrupted, uniform helps to keep security robust.
