Dear Parent/Carer,

As you are well aware, the car parks at Grange Campus can be extremely busy at the start and end of the school day, as are the surrounding access roads. Your patience with this situation is greatly appreciated however with safety as our first priority, all users are asked to follow the existing signage and road markings which are in place to facilitate organised and safe movement of traffic. In particular, we ask all users to avoid parking for any length of time in the following areas:

- Disabled spaces (unless you have a disability badge);
- Drop-off points;
- Restricted zones and verges on Beech Avenue; and
- Bus bay, (on entering from Beech Avenue, all cars should turn left into the main car
 park rather than entering the bus bay on the right to drop off passengers). Please
 give priority to buses!
