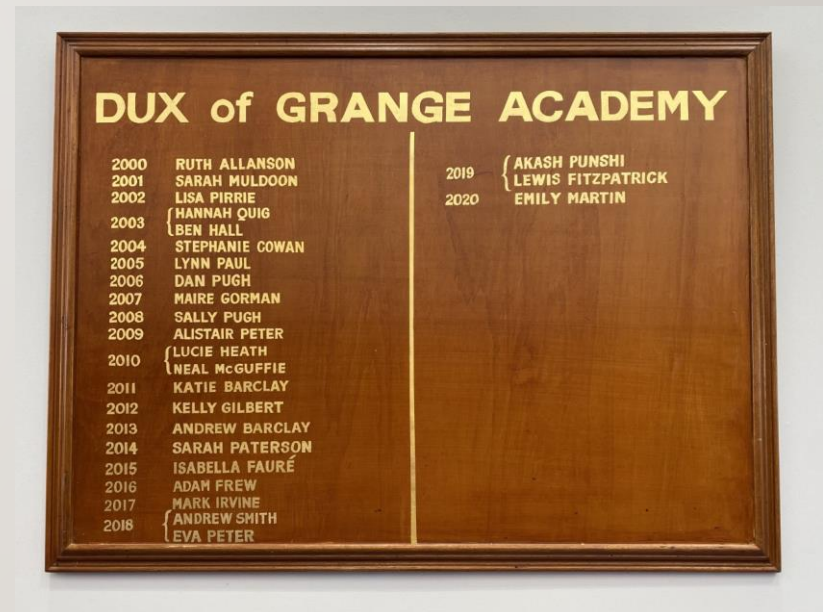

She was awarded her medal by Mr Johnston last week, in recognition of her fantastic academic achievements.



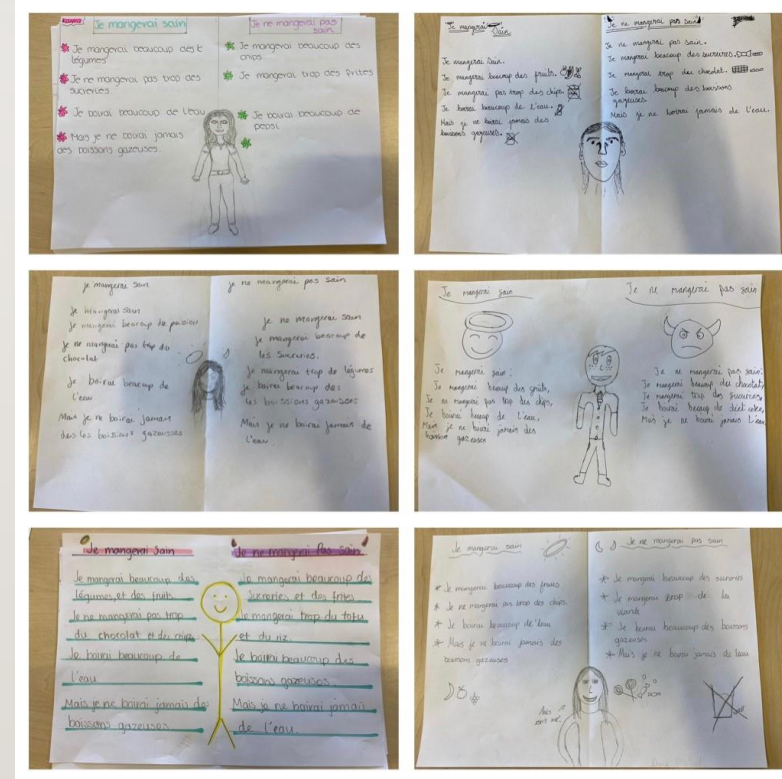
SOPHIE

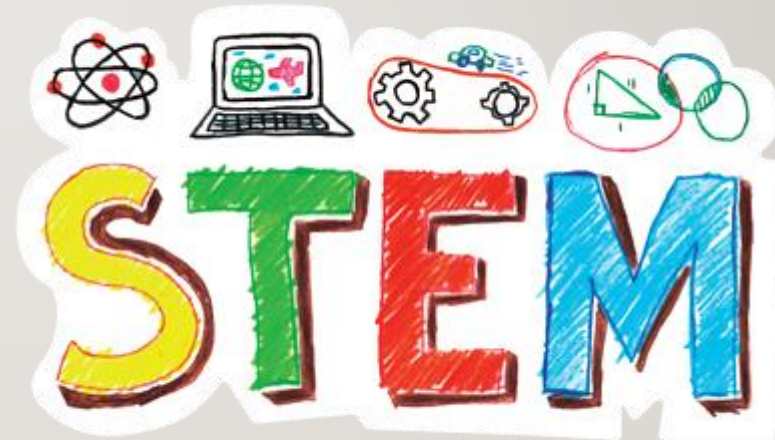
