Dear Parent/Carer,

Having worked very hard over the years to establish a good standard of school uniform here at Grange Academy, it was with a heavy heart that we took the decision last week to encourage

young people to come to school 'appropriately' dressed on days they have PE. This followed updated national Health & Safety guidance regarding the use of PE changing rooms and needless to say, this has inevitably resulted in a deterioration in standards of uniform.

For the most part, pupils have been coming to school dressed appropriately however some are pushing the boundaries and I would once again ask for your support in ensuring that your son/daughter is dressed in appropriate clothing for the school day when they have PE.

Realising that some young people may consider me to be a bit 'out of touch' when it comes to fashion I sought the wise counsel of some of our S6 pupils on what would be regarded as 'appropriate' clothes for school. Their advice was very sensible and included such things as:

- Full length leggings rather than shorts preferably;
- If shorts are worn these should be knee length / cycling and not too short;
- Full length T-shirt / top rather than a crop-top;
- Tracksuit bottoms rather than jeans; and
- No football colours.

As a general guideline to see us through these challenging times I would ask that all young people, boys and girls, dress smartly, modestly and with a level of decorum appropriate to the school environment.
