# School Uniform



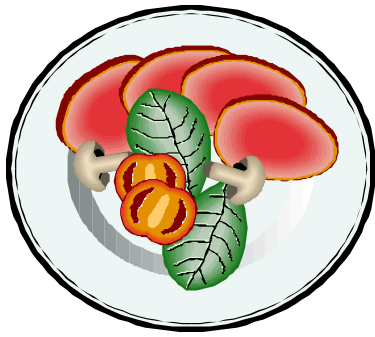
Clothing / items of jewellery not allowed are those which:

- carry advertising, particularly for alcohol or tobacco

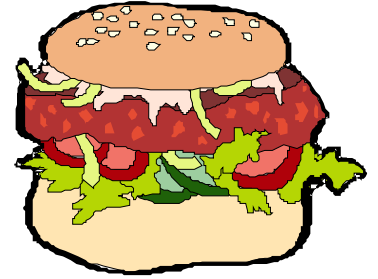
# Why School Uniform?

- Encourages a work ethos as preparation for the future.

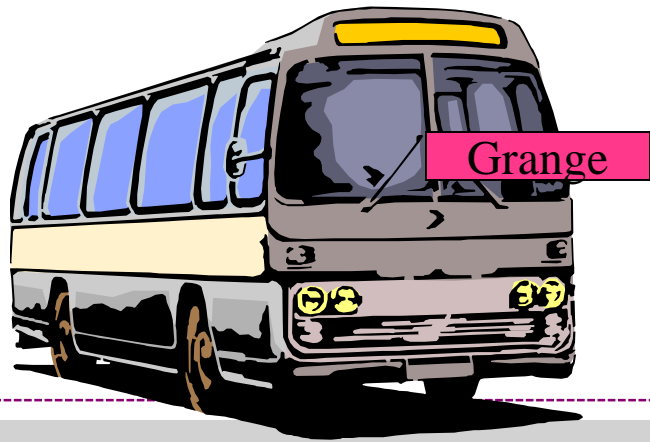


# Lunch

# New Class Teams



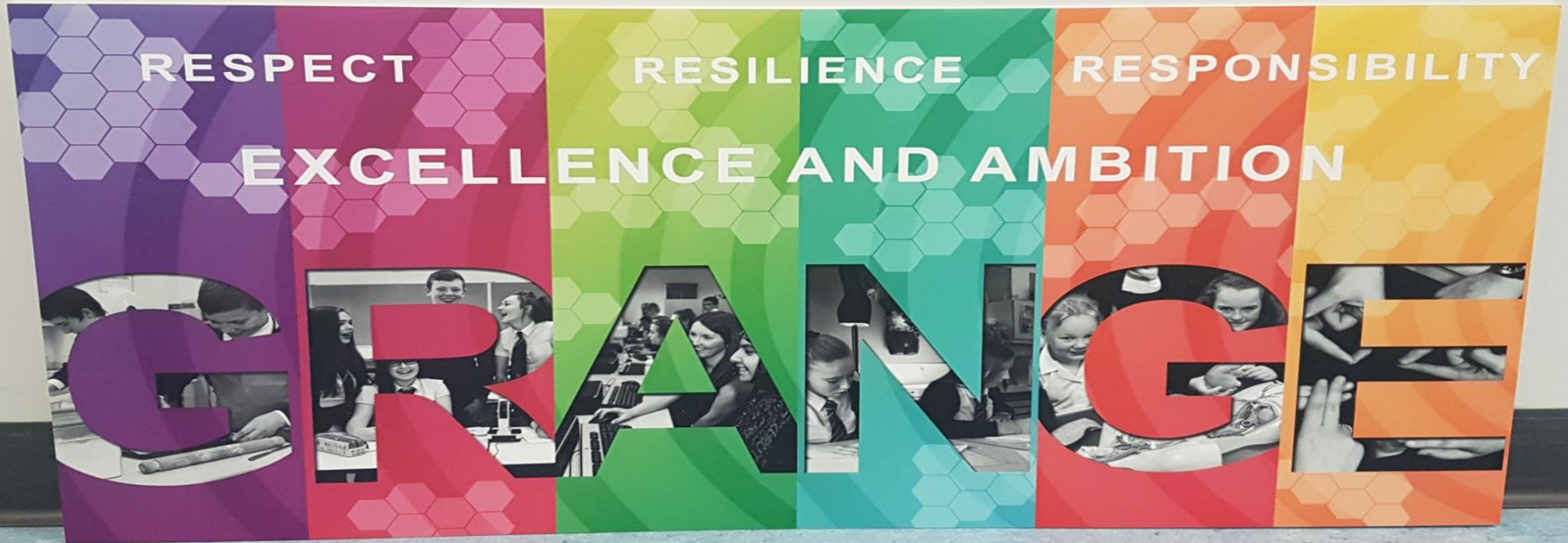
- Pupils will be added to 2 new Teams Groups
