

Can you find the bunny that is unique?



The first is a football challenge based on the volley. In teams, you have one minute to score as many volleys as possible.


You might have seen a very similar challenge on the Sky Sports show Soccer AM and you might see some clips in PE of Grange staff giving it a go!




Miss Baird's fabulous S2 class were extracting copper from its ore! Everyone was able to take part safely because they had their uniform on and their experiment results were excellent!


Mr Alldridge's transgender support group will meet this Thursday, period 7 in the library.

The Foodbank were delighted with the donations collected last day before we finished for the October Holiday!


We'll do another foodbank donation just before we stop for Christmas holidays.
