There are a range of online talks and workshops, including a Comic & Zine Making Workshop and Bold Types: Creative Writing Showcase (16+) (for seniors only!).



Look out for the display showcasing books with their especially exciting opening lines over the front cover! You'll maybe want to read the whole book to find out how the story pans out!


For the competition, Miss Cooper is challenging you to come up with the most exciting opening line you can think up... the ones that make our librarian want to keep reading will get a prize!

With S3-5 School of Rugby pupils volunteering to help out, the event was a massive success. Thanks to the girls, teachers, coaches and volunteers!






Sign of the Week (chosen by Llayton Scoular in S2): 44Football?

All S6 pupils taking part in Gold Duke of Edinburgh should attend a meeting in the library today at 1.30pm with Mr Livingstone.



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
