The club takes place from **3.40pm to 4.40pm** with Miss Shankland – come along and give it a go!



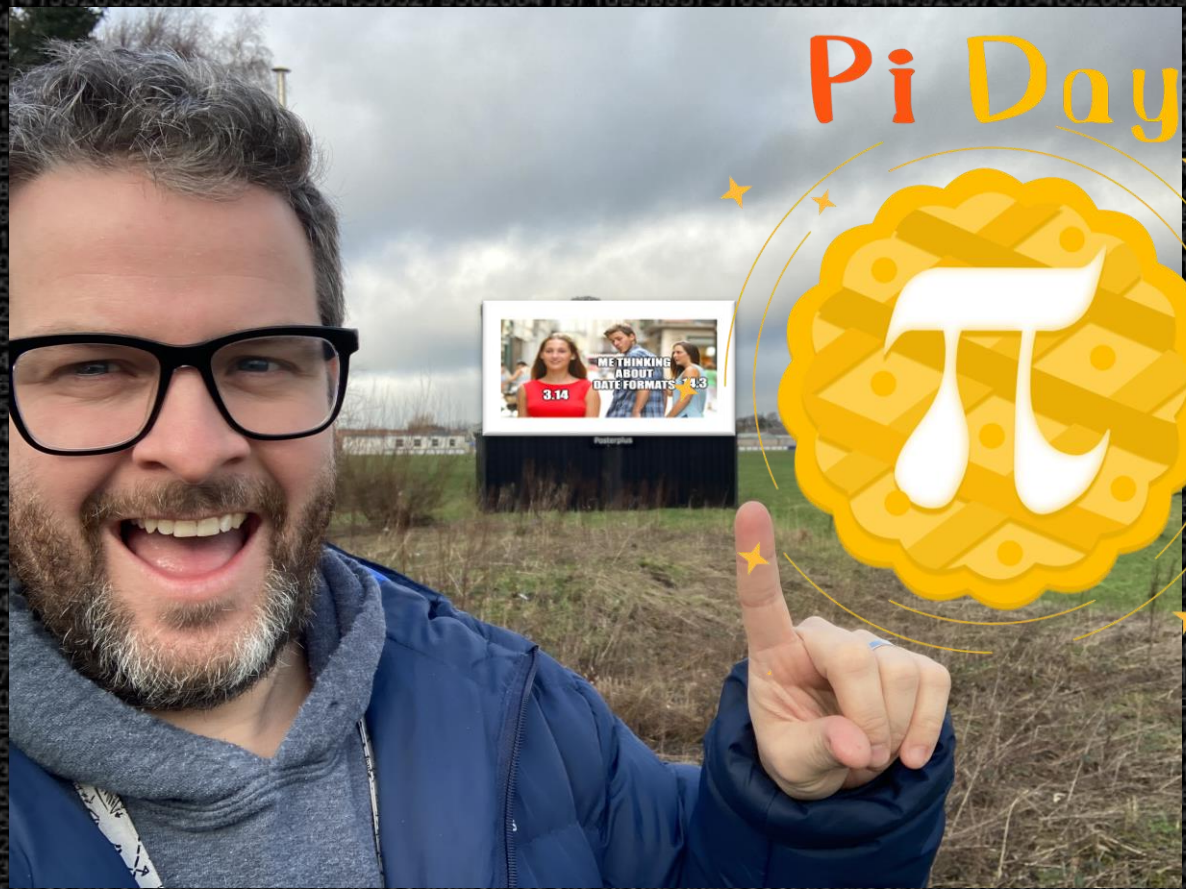
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Pi Day

3. Videos must be 10 second long MP4s, H.264 codec 25 frames per second, with a maximum filesize of 25MB.

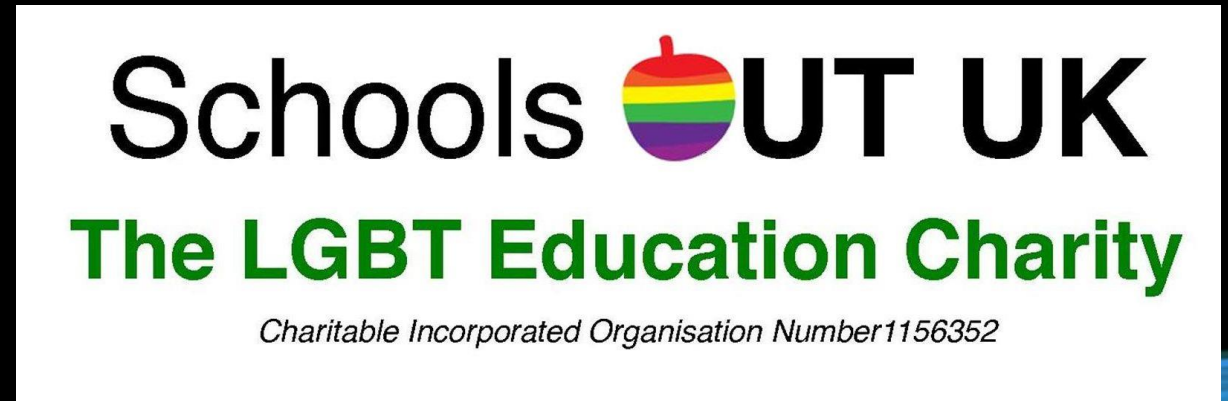

Miss Barrie's Higher Psychology classes are looking for some help with their experiment and assignment write up.

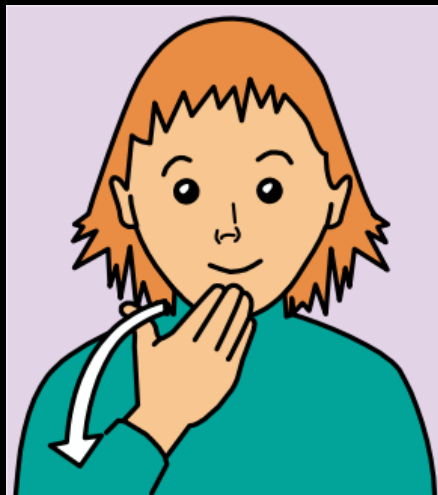
They will be contacting individual pupils and staff over the age of 16 to take part in their experiment.
