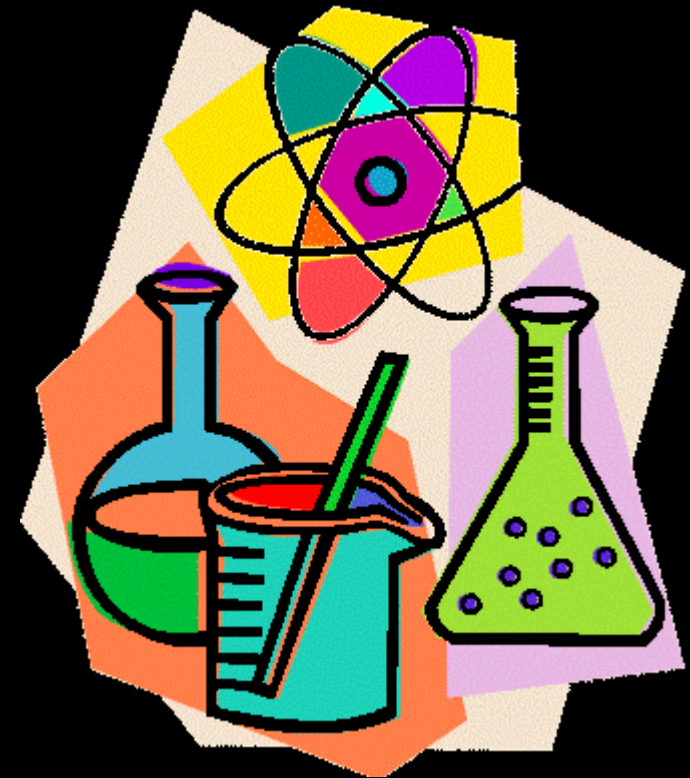

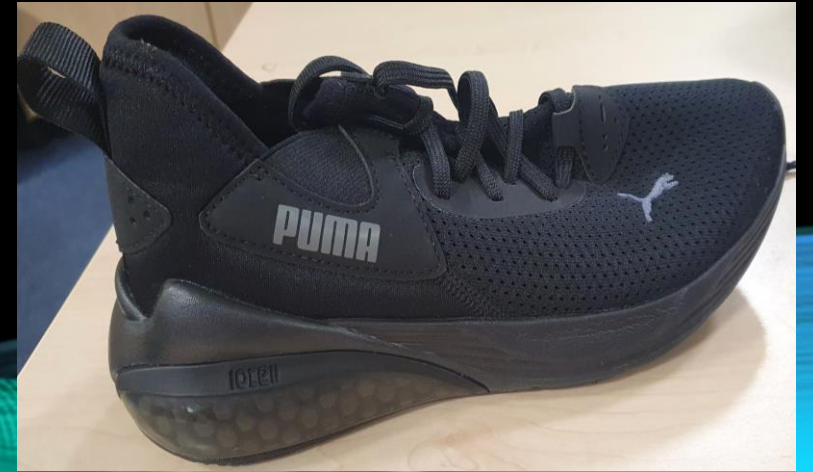

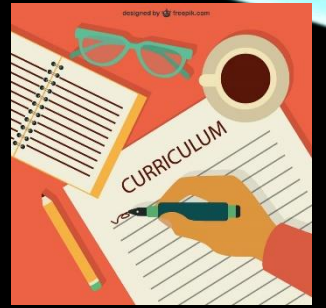
WELL DONE S3 MODERN LINGUISTS!

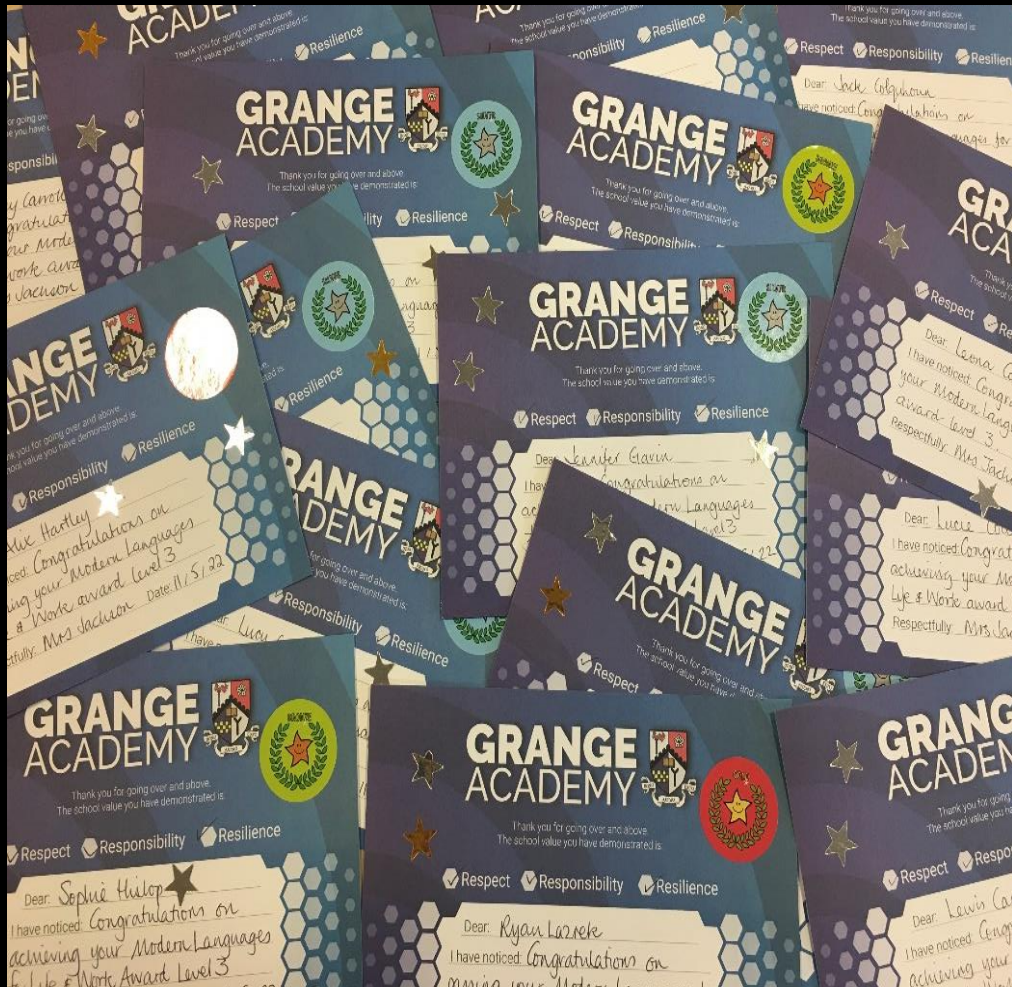

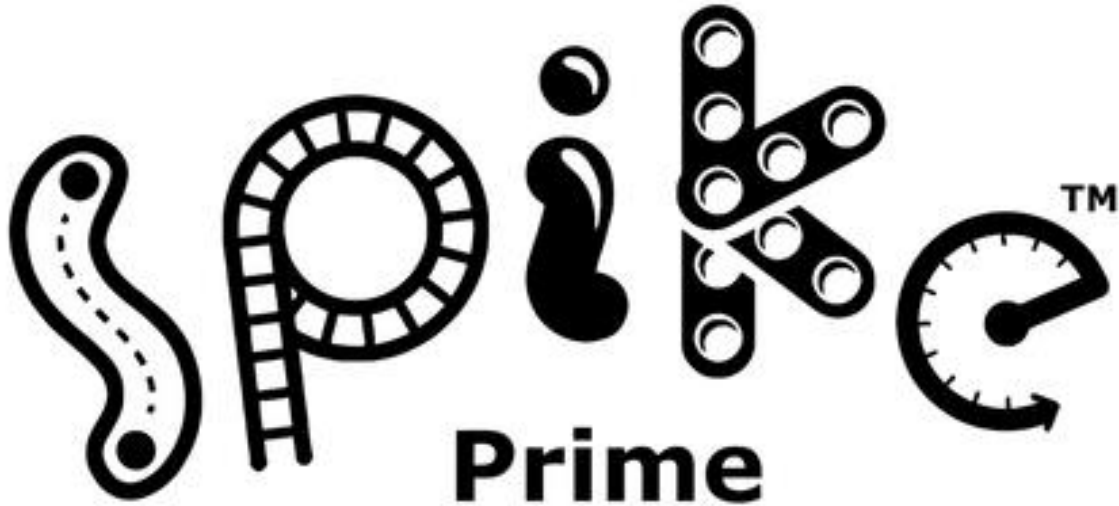

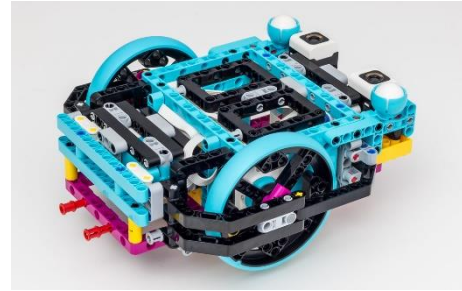

- You are eligible for Covid treatment

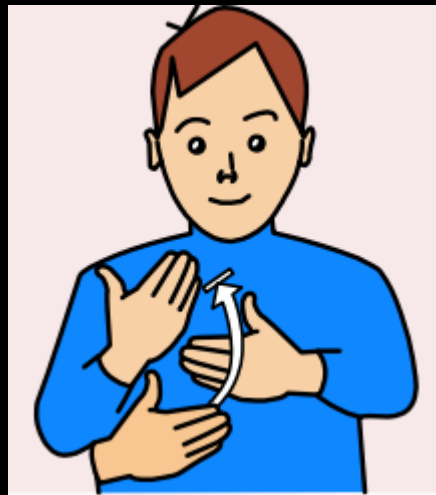
