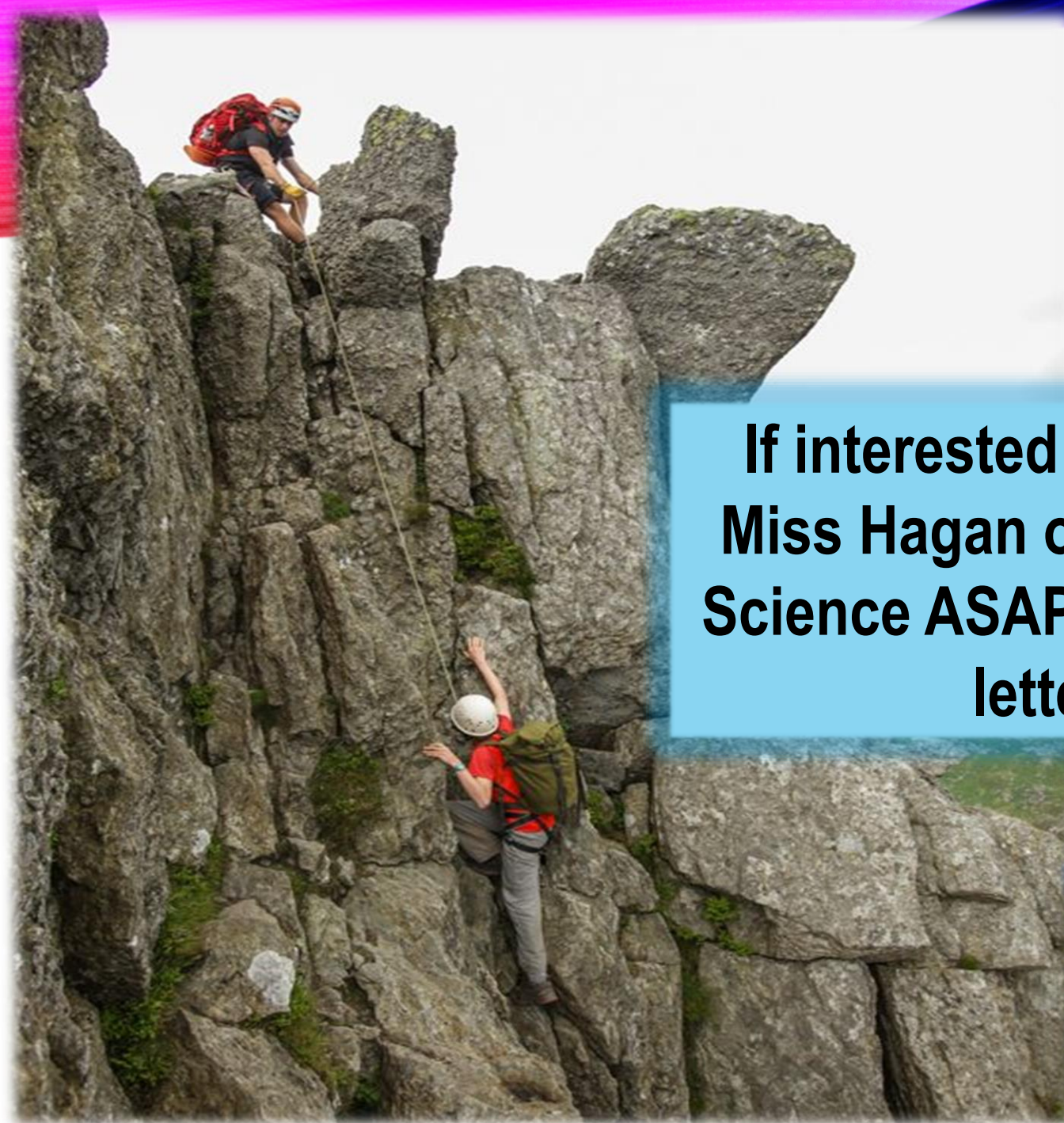

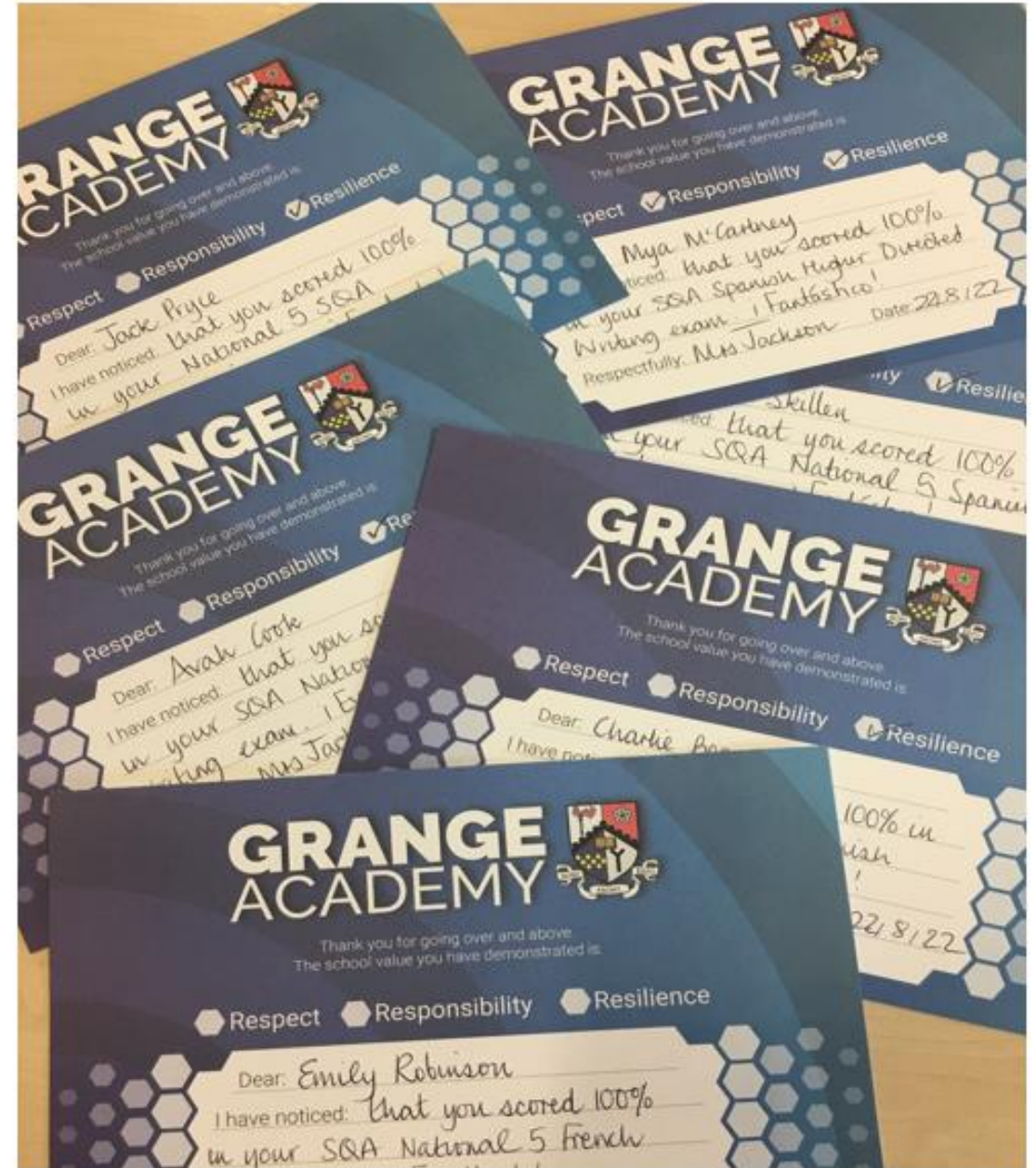
Modern Languages Ambassadors
