S1 INTER-HOUSE DODGEBALL


There will be inter-house dodgeball for all \$1 pupils on:

Maths Camp is open to all Advanced Higher Maths, Higher Maths and \$6 National 5 Maths students.


Please be aware, deposits are due by the **end of September** (we've had loads already but plenty of space to squeeze more Maths Campers in).


