

If you want to join in the fun, there's still time to create your own Mathematical song...


Check out Mr Smith's example on YouTube – it's time for all the Mathe-musicians out there to get creative!






We work hard to challenge poverty at Grange Academy!









Grange Academy has 3 breakfast clubs. These are free and open to everyone from 8.15am each morning.

PSE lessons will be themed to link in with Challenge Poverty Week. This will be your chance to give your ideas to your teacher!






Pupil Equity Fund & Hardship Fund

ENTERPRISING MATHS SUCCESS!


Congratulations to the Grange team of mathletes who were runners-up in the East Ayrshire Enterprising Maths Regional Qualifier.
