
Performing

- Highlight lines you are saying to make them clearer to read and in pencil write down any stage directions given during your initial read through and rehearsals.
- Read over lines with your group, family and friends to give yourself the chance to rehearse.
- Work on characterisation through activities like hot seating and writing in role.
- Record any lines you have and listen back to them to make sure you remember them.
- Walk around following the stage directions when you are rehearsing to ensure you know what you are doing.
- Video your performance to see where you are going right and where you are going wrong. Give yourself 2 stars and a wish to ensure you giving yourself constructive feedback.
- Arrange rehearsals in your free time i.e. lunchtimes or breaks



Written

- Read over any booklets given containing terminology so you can familiarise yourself with it.
- Use flashcards
- Do past papers under timed conditions
- Watch as many live theatrical performances as possible (in person or online)
