

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The S6 group photo will take place on <u>Friday 9th December</u> at 9am in the assembly hall.


Can all S6 pupils please make their way to the assembly hall at this time with their full uniform.

Make the shape of a Christmas tree. Start at the peak and draw out the branches, getting bigger as you go down.




