Magic Breakfast




Breakfast is now served at Grange!

Crochet Club


Before Christmas, Miss Cooper popped into the PSB to do some crochet lessons.

If any pupils would like to learn how to crochet please come to the library on **Wednesday at lunchtime**!












Heriot-Watt Graduate Apprenticeship Fair




- On <u>Wednesday 21st February 2024</u>, Heriot-Watt are holding their inaugural Graduate Apprenticeship Recruitment Fair.




