Now every pupil can have a **free** breakfast from the canteen starting from today.

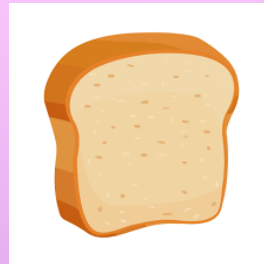

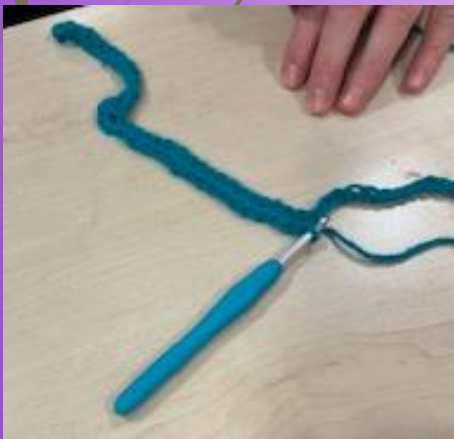
Crochet Club

We have been contacted by a lovely group of former Grange Academy pupils who are now studying Musical Theatre in Glasgow.



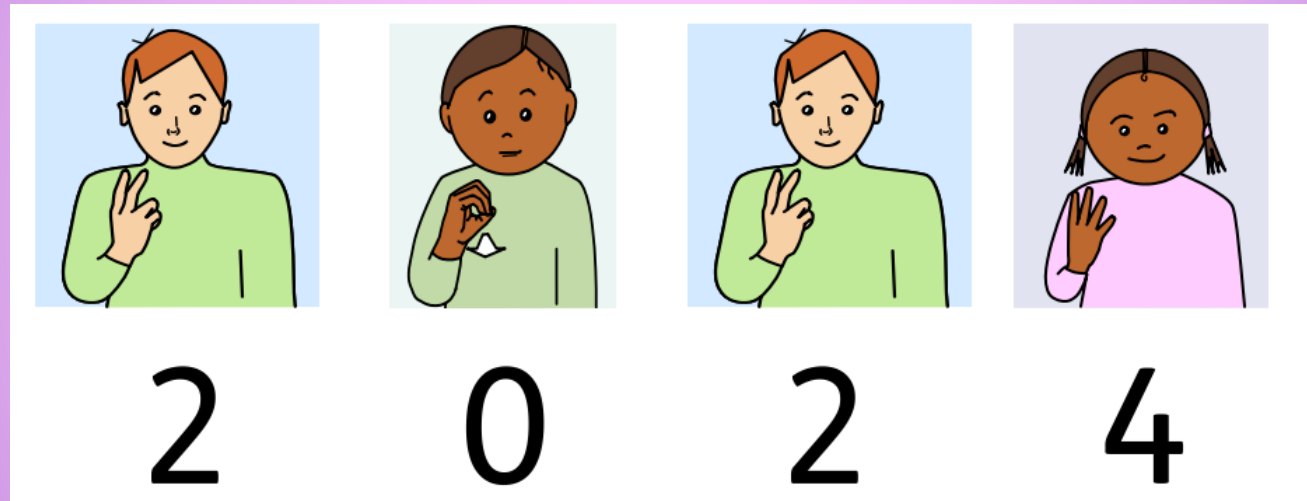
