

# Photographic Pet Show












Step 1: Scan the QR code or follow the link and fill out the entry form.

Yes, the point of the pet show is to have fun, but also to raise money for the school fund.






Step 4: All entries will be displayed on Friday 21<sup>st</sup> June (location in school to be decided – depends on how many entries there are!)
