These individuals interviewed each pupil and provided constructive feedback to the pupils to help support them as they move into the next stage of life. Thank you to everyone involved!



Well done to our S1's that took part in the virtual "Could you be an entrepreneur?" event with Young Enterprise Scotland. The pupils involved learned all about the skills and qualities required to become an entrepreneur and began to develop their own skills.

St. Andrew's First Aid kindly sent a volunteer to help our National 5 Health Sector class learn how to provide life support in an emergency situation.

In February, a group of Seniors attended the EAC Futureskills event. Here they learned about the various apprenticeship opportunities available to them within East Ayrshire Council.



At Grange we have started many new courses that help to develop the young workforce. Our newest course, Powering Futures, will require students to create a sustainable solution to real world challenges set by businesses. In doing this, pupils will develop valuable meta-skills that they can take into their future careers.

Throughout this year we have had a number of businesses in to deliver careers talks:

- Scottish Power Renewables delivered a virtual talk on their apprenticeships opportunities.
- The British Army presented information about the 100+ careers they offer.
- Mascot Civils introduced civil engineering and the career and apprenticeship opportunities available with themselves and in the energy sector.



Futurefest 2024 was our biggest careers fayre yet! There were over 50 external agencies present on the night to inspire and inform our pupils about their future career choices.
