 The Young WEIR-WISE initiative, a partnership between the Faculty of Engineering at Strathclyde University and The Weir Group, is designed to inspire S2 female students to discover the excitement and personal satisfaction behind a career in engineering.



 You will take part in a series of practical activities, including creating nano-polymer bouncy balls, and building your own moveable hand.

The WEIR-WISE Programme

- The programme will run in 2025 with 300 places available, and is open to all S2 girls in Scotland.
- 200 pupils will attend a two-day in-person event at the University of Strathclyde campus on either the 13th-14th of January 2024 or 16th-17 of January 2025
- 100 pupils will attend the one-day virtual event on 22nd of January 2025.
- Participants will hear from staff at the University and colleagues from the Weir Group who will provide insight into studying and working in the field of engineering.

Miss Cameron will be running a Drama Club every Tuesday lunchtime (starting at 1.15pm) in G138.


The first meeting of the club will be on Tuesday 1st October (tomorrow) and it is open to all year groups.

Over the September weekend a group of 21 S5/6 pupils went with Dr Mitchell, Mr McPherson and Mr Cree to the European Space Center in Belgium












Building and launching gunpowder rockets that deploy a parachute











Experiencing the Space Rotor – a centrifuge that lets you feel a g-force of 2.7






Shuttle Launch Simulator – 6 in the control room, 2 in the spacecraft







BSL Recap


Can you remember the sign from the last bulletin?
