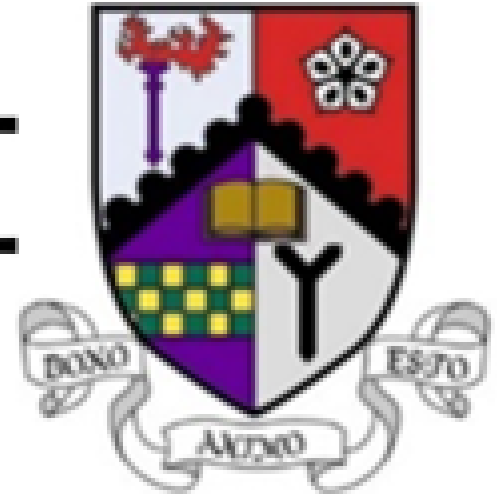

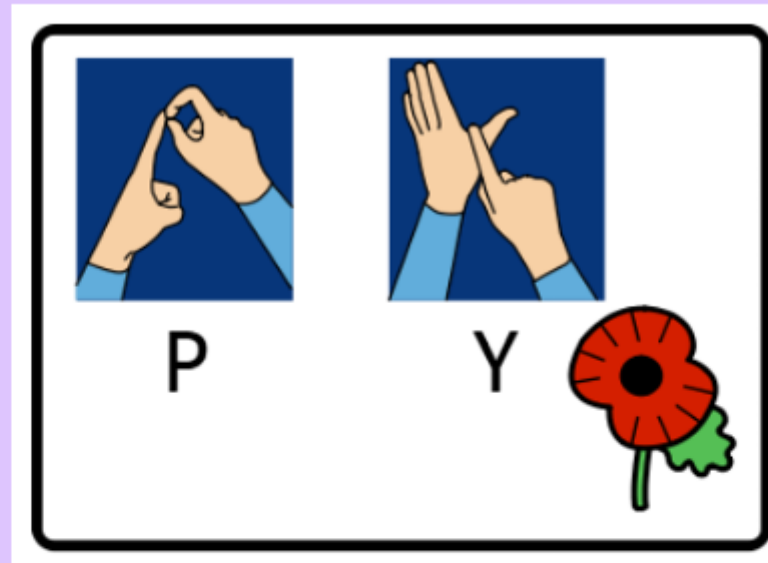

Can you remember the sign from the last bulletin?

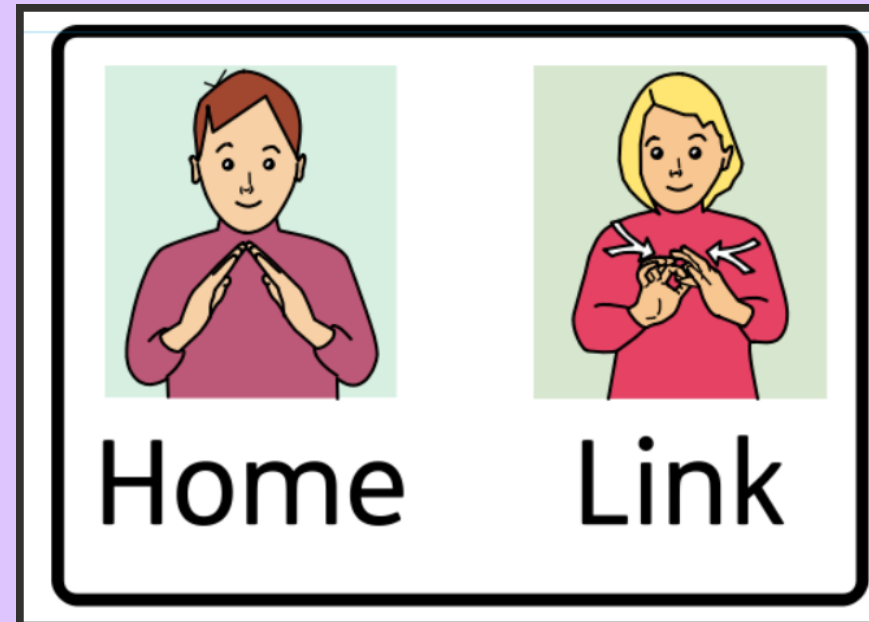


Make a circle with your fingers and thumb. Place it at the tip of your pointer finger (this is the letter P).
