Medic Insight Glasgow Committee – S4 Only




Medic Insight Glasgow Committee are running their annual day programme this February and would encourage all S4 students interested in a career in medicine to apply.





Lost Property





There are several items of lost property at the main office. If you believe any of these items belong to you, please collect them by Friday 7th February. After this date, the items will be disposed of.
