

 The Scottish Space School is an exciting initiative supported by the international space community to inspire and motivate young people to study science and engineering and consider careers in these areas.

 It is hosted by the University of Strathclyde, Department of Electronic and Electrical Engineering along with NASA in the United States.

## What Is Space School?

- This years Space School programme will take place at Strathclyde University from Monday 9 Friday 13 June 2025.
- This is a non-residential week. Pupils should be able to make their own way there each day, to Strathclyde University Campus and take part in a series of workshops from 9am-5pm.
- The programme will provide attendees with an opportunity to take part in an eclectic mix of space-themed lectures, labs and workshops and to learn from some of the world's leading figures in space travel, including NASA astronauts and engineers.
- There are only 100 spaces available.








## NASA – Johnson Space Centre Houston,




Place your hands like the picture - your middle fingers should be touching your jumper.
