Literacy

P2– Will continue to work through stage 2 of the Active Literacy Spelling Programme and will be learning different sounds using a split phoneme. In reading we will continue using our BugClub books and pupils will be encouraged to ask questions prior to reading which they can then answer after reading. Pupils will be focusing on summarising the stories they read in their own words. For grammar we will be reinforcing everything we have learned so far this year. In writing we will be writing responses to our reading books including our own thoughts about the book.

P3– Will continue working through Stage 3 of the Active Literacy Spelling Programme. In reading we will continue using our BugClub books and children will learn to make connections between their personal experiences and the events that happen throughout their books. They will also be creating questions for their peers to answer. For grammar we will be revising and reinforcing everything we have learned so far this year. In writing we will be writing responses to a text discussing what we did and did not like about it and will include whether or not we would recommend this to a friend with justifying reasons.

Topic

This term Primary 2/3 will be exploring a history based topic of the Vikings. They will learn about Viking lives, houses, battles, trade, food and clothes.

Numeracy and Maths

<u>P2</u> – Are learning about time. They are learning about analogue and digital time and will focus specifically on times on the hour and half past the hour. They will also learn about daily routines and will be able to split them into day time and night time starting to recognise am and pm.

<u>P3 –</u> Are learning about time. They are also learning about digital and analogue time focusing specifically on times on the hour, half past, quarter past and quarter to the hour. They will learn about am and pm and make links to daily activities.

<u>All children</u> are encouraged to continue revising times tables at home. We will re-visit these regularly in class through a range of activities. Counting in 5s would also be encouraged as we will use this to make links when reading the time.
