This week we are consolidating words with the ae sound including the following phonemes; oo, u-e, ew, ue and u.

I would like you to focus oo and u-e sound.

It would be useful to practise reading the words below. Any words you find a bit trickier to read could be your focus words for homework tasks from the spelling menu. Alternatively take a random selection of words from each column. I suggest one activity per night.
