Reading and Spelling

We will continue to use the Active Literacy programme to develop our phoneme and common word knowledge. We will explore a variety of strategies to support and challenge our knowledge and skills.

The class have been enjoying "The Wilderness War" by Julia Green and we will complete the novel and literacy circle reading tasks this term . We will also be reading for pleasure, share our thoughts on our favourite genre of novels, and recommend books we have enjoyed to each other, discussing what it is we enjoy about different authors and types of books.

Writing

Listening & Talking

Our focus for numeracy will be decimal place, fractions and multiplication and division calculations. Mrs Conetta will be focusing on maths and in particular angles and tessalations.
