COMMUNICATION CHAMPION'S TOP TIP FOR JUNE! And RHYME OF THE MONTH!

This month we are looking at how we can help our children to pronounce their sounds correctly. Different sounds are learned at different stages of their development and we shouldn't worry if there are some sounds they find difficult to pronounce. It is important that we don't make our children feel embarrassed or awkward about saying a word incorrectly so if they do say a word wrong just repeat the word back to them the correct way without making a big deal of it.

The rhyme of the month is "Mary Mary Quite Contrary"

This rhyme was chosen as we have been growing some lovely vegetables in our garden and the children have been helping to water and nurture the plants.
