Additional year


Following discussions, a link to apply for an additional place should be completed

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


Lending Library!



During the day, we will be reading our favourite stories which make us feel happy and exploring the emotion across all the areas.



Each Monday we are inviting parents/carers to join their child's group to have the opportunity to read stories together in the School Library.






Spare Clothing
