Child Protection Officer





Mrs Cardow: Child Protection Officer

The Child Protection Officer in Grange Academy is **Mrs Cardow.**Mrs Cardow recently interviewed a small group of pupils and found out that they weren't aware of who the Child Protection Officer is in the school, or their role in the school.

The Child Protection Officer is someone who makes sure that all students feel safe and are looked after.

Their main job is to listen to young people if they are worried, upset, or don't feel safe, whether at school, at home, or anywhere else. They take a young person's concerns seriously and make sure the right help is given. The Child Protection Officer will step in to support a young person who feels unsafe and work with teachers, families, or other services to protect them. They are there to protect children's rights, make school a safe place, and ensure everyone has the chance to learn and grow without fear.

Many concerns come to Mrs Cardow through a young person speaking to their guidance teacher or a teacher they feel comfortable talking to. Staff also come and speak to Mrs Cardow if they are concerned about the safety of a young person.


