
Primary 6/7 Newsletter

Numeracy: We have started Term 2 looking at measuring Perimeter and Area before returning to number and how to multiply and divide numbers including decimals. We will also be investigating 2D and 3D shape as well as net construction—as our games need boxes!

Expressive Arts: will be looking at a range of media and digital media to create their games, boxes and instruction cards being mindful of themes and colour motifs to inform their design.
