

## Active Spelling Homework Activities - Term 2

Select at least two to be completed each week using the spelling words inside your jotter. Try to use each activity at least once during the term.

- **Rainbow Writing** - write each of your spelling words three times, each in a different colour.
- **Headlines** - cut letters out of newspapers and magazines to spell out your words. Stick them into your jotter.
- **Curly Words** - First write your spelling words out in normal letters, then write them again in curly letters.
- **Back Writing** - write your words on a partner's back and see if they can guess what the word is. Swap and repeat. Try to feel each letter.
- **Toss - A - Word** - toss or roll a ball to your partner. You say the first letter, then pass the ball, and your partner says the second, and so on.
- **Good Clean Words** - Find a surface that can be cleaned easily. Spray a small amount of shaving cream and spread it out. Write your spelling words and then clean up afterwards!
- **Sentences** - write a sentence using each of your words.
- **Bright Words** - write your words in coloured pens, pencils or highlighters.
- **Rhyming Words** - Write each of your spelling words. Next to each word, write a rhyming word. If necessary, your rhyming word can be a nonsense word (as long as it follows the same spelling pattern).
- **Pyramid Writing** - Pyramid write your spelling words. Try to write neatly.
