
Primary 4/5 Newsletter

We have had a great start to the year. All children have regular access to the library which the committee will promote across the whole school. We have identified jobs for the outdoor area and have taken some big steps forward in our learning. We have continued with addition using exchanging but will soon be looking at subtraction and then 2D and 3D shapes as well as angles, symmetry and transformation. Please work with your children on their 2, 4 and 5 multiplication tables and don't forget the Sumdog challenges.

At the end of Term 1 we began to learn how to play the recorder. This will continue up until December where we will be looking at singing for the School Show!

In Health and Wellbeing our focus will be the skills and routines for leading a healthy and happy life including regular sleep, healthy eating, regular exercise and good hygiene.
