Dear Parent/Carer,

Welcome back! I hope you have had a lovely Summer break! We are looking forward to welcoming back our pupils on Thursday 18th August.



On Thursday 18th August and Friday 19th August, our Primary 1s will have an informal drop off, entering via the door in our Early Childhood Playground between 9.15 and 9.45am. Parents/Carers may come in with their child and take a picture before leaving their child. At 2.30pm, please pick up your child in the infant playground at the dinner hall door. From Monday 22nd August, Primary 1 will line up in the infant playground.

This session, we continue to have our staggered starts and finishes, as follows:

P5-P7: 8.50am - 2.50pm

P1-P4: 9 - 3pm

At the start of the day, P1, P2, P3/2, P3 will line up in the infant playground and P4S, P4F, P5, P6, P7 will line up in the main playground.

At playtime and lunchtime, P1, P2, P3/2, P3 will play in the infant playground and P4S, P4F, P5, P6, P7 play in the main playground

At the end of the day, P4F, P4S, P5 P6, P7 will exit via the main door at 2.50pm. At 3pm, P1, P2, P3/2, P3 will exit into infant playground. Please come forward to pick up your child.



What can your child bring to school?

We would like your support in encouraging your child to wear school uniform each day. We have some second hand uniform available if you need anything. Please contact the main office if we can be of help. Children are allowed to bring a **school bag** to school. Please ensure all items are labelled to ensure items can be returned to their owner, should they become lost. Pupils require a **PE kit**, which may include shorts/leggings/joggers and trainers/sand shoes(outdoor trainers are fine!) No earrings/jewellery on PE days please.

PE days: Mondays: P2 and P3. Tuesdays : P3/2, P4S Miss Steedman, P5. Wednesdays: P4 Miss Barclay, Thursdays: P1, P6. Fridays: P7



Pupils can bring a **water bottle** to school. Please remember

children can only drink water in class – no juice please. P1 pupils will be given a school water bottle with their name on it for use in school. This can be taken home, but it should be returned filled each day.

Each child will be provided with **resources** for use, this will include: pencil, pens, coloured pencils, eraser, sharpener, ruler, glue, etc. These will be kept in school. Children can bring their own pencils/pens, if they wish. Children should not bring in toys from
