Last session, we had a number of responses in our Parent/Carer Questionnaires asking for a more structured approach to Homework. We hope the following information will be helpful, as you support your child with completing homework:

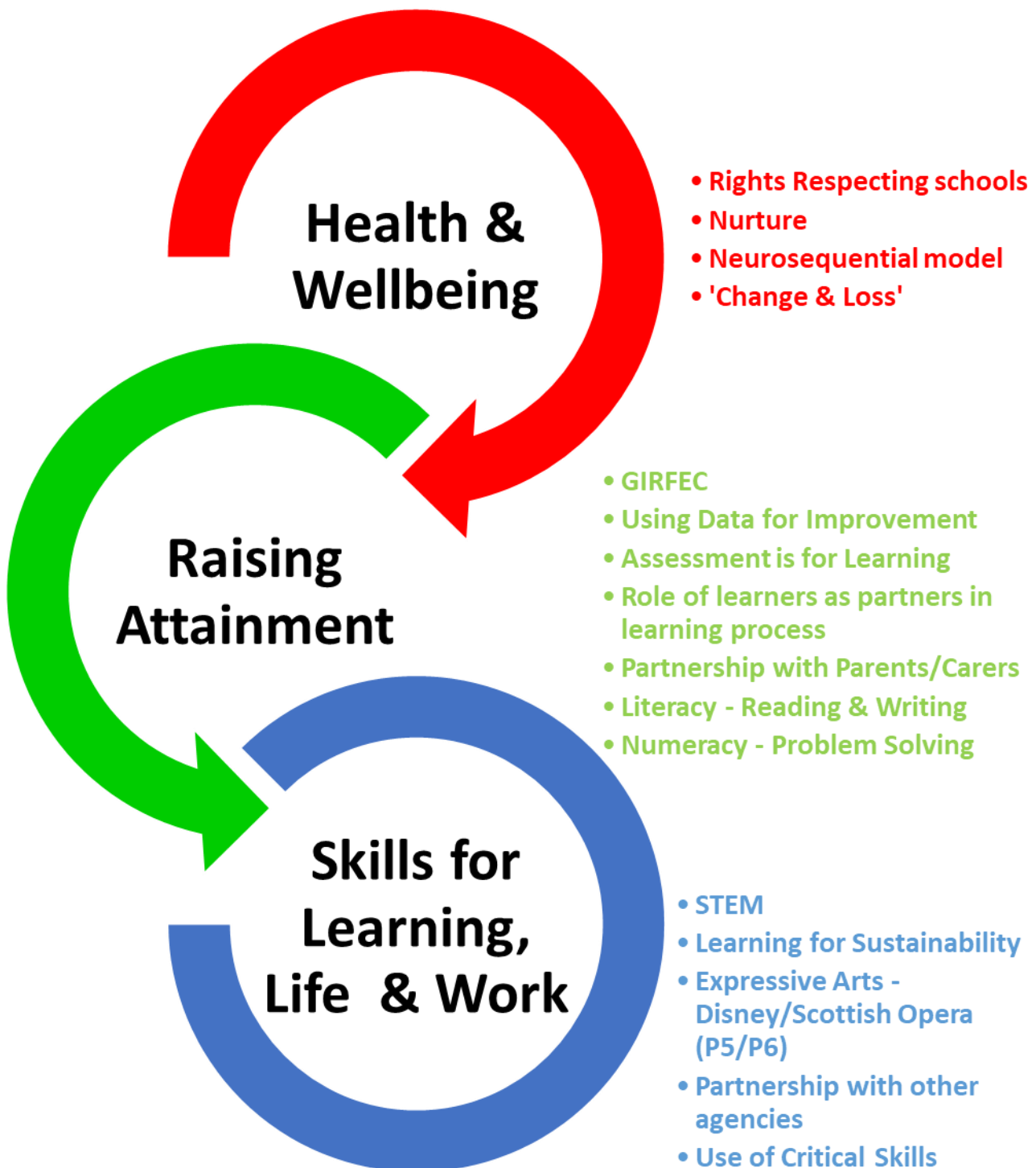
- All classes will have sounds / spelling homework issued on a Monday
- All pupils should choose **2** active spelling tasks **per week** from the grid at the front of their homework jotter and complete in their homework jotters.
- Homework jotters will be collected / handed in on a Friday Morning.
- Spelling tests will be on a Friday.
- There is an explanation grid for the active spelling tasks at the back of the homework jotter, if required.
- There may also be reading / maths homework given out and the will be written either on the "Things to Remember" or be in the homework jotter.
- "Talk for Writing" tasks should be completed prior to the Writing Day. This is on the "Things to Remember" sheet at the front of the jotter.
- We plan to have some Parent/Carer workshops in due course, to help you support your child at home.

Homework will commence on the week beginning 26th September, 22

We are aware of the many pressures on families and we do not want homework to be an added pressure.

Just do what you can to support your child with homework.
