Start on number one, follow the instruction and throw the dice. If you land on an activity square, follow the instruction. If you land on a sum, complete the sum and go to the number square that is the answer to that sum. E.g. $2 + 2 = 4$ Go to square number 4.





Please ask an adult to take a picture of your family maps and story and send it back to your iLunch worker.


