Literacy

Reading

Through our novel How to Train a Dragon, we will be developing our skills in skimming and scanning for evidence and using this evidence to justify our answers in comprehension work. We will be examining the themes of the novel and analysing the story characters and plot. We will enjoy a movie afternoon nearer the end of term and compare the elements of film and literature.

Spelling

We will continue to embed our new spelling programme, Wrap Around· Pupils have been enjoying the new format and it is showing excellent results to enhance their spelling capabilities·

Numeracy

Division

We will continue to develop our division strategies. Please continue to revise all tables at home, as this will help with division work.

Fractions/Decimals/Percentages

In January, we will be revising equivalent fractions and will learn how to simplify fractions: We will progress onto decimals recognising they are a different way to represent a fraction. We will learn to add and subtract decimals to one place. Finally, we will study percentages and its relationship to fractions/decimals. We will practise calculating simple percentages of quantities.

Money and Measure

P5 will be learning about measure; calculating the perimeter, area and volume of shapes· We will also develop our understanding of money·

Contexts for Learning

Vikings

We will investigate people and events in the past through our Vikings study. We will explore the clothing, food, traditions and lifestyles of Vikings. We will practise our map reading skills and learn about Scotland's historical links to the Vikings.

ICT
