Stewarton Academy P7 Induction Days - Tuesday 21st & Wednesday 22nd May 2024

Dear Parent/Carer,

Our P7 Induction Days will take place on Tuesday 21st and Wednesday 22nd May 2023. All pupils will have the opportunity to visit the school on both days and follow a typical S1 timetable.

Travel Arrangements

Your child should arrive at Stewarton Academy by 9.00am and the school day will end at 2.45pm on Tuesday and 2.00pm on Wednesday. Associated Primary Schools will manage the transport arrangements for pupil groups, full details will be issued nearer the time. If you are joining us from another primary school, we ask that pupils make their own way to and from school on both days.

School Uniform

On Tuesday 21st May, pupils should wear school uniform from their current primary school.

On Wednesday 22nd May pupils should come to school wearing suitable PE kit. PE kit consists of trainers, jogging trousers or shorts and a t-shirt (no football colours). As some of the activities will be outside it would be helpful if pupils also bring a suitable outdoor jacket/sweatshirt.

Lunch Arrangements

All P7 pupils will have access to the school Cafeteria on both days of the visit. We will be operating week 1 of the East Ayrshire Menu for Tuesday and Wednesday. Onsite Services are offering a complementary meal for all P7 pupils on both days. There will be a significant choice of hot food available.
