Language and Literacy         This month we will continue to read our novel Goodnight Mr Tom', exploring the various themes of war. To conclude our unit study we will watch the film to compare the media of literature and film.         In reading we will be developing our skills in paraphrasing, responding to a variety of short texts and explaining them in our own words. We will also be focusing on summarising texts ensuring we include only the key events or themes of the text.         In writting we will be exploring how to structure pieces of critical writting using mise-enscene. The children also requested to research Invercive and create a leaflet displaying all the information they need to know for their residential.	NumeracyThis term we will be working with positive and negative numbers, examining them in real life contexts such as temperature, banking, sea levels, co-ordinates etc.We will be learning how to interpret data from a variety of tables and graphs. We will be drawing line and curved graphs using continuous data such as temperature changes. We will be drawing and interpreting data from pie charts using our knowledge of angles.We will be investigating 3D shape and their nets, as well as learning about probability and chance.
<u>Health</u> <u>PE</u> - This term's focus will be games; consisting of possession games of hockey, football and rugby. Target games of golf and frisbee and fielding games such as cricket and rounders. <u>UNRCC –</u> We will continue to study various articles of the UNRCC through our Right of the Week with themes of refugees, healthy choices, child labour etc.	Contexts for Learning It's going to be a sporty term with our topics linked to the Euro Football competition and the Olympic games. We will examine the history of the Olympic games and create a timeline. We will explore the rules of some of the 320 sports and have fun playing these in our PE sessions. Each pupil will choose a sport to learn about and create a PowerPoint to share with the rest of the class.
