In writing, we will focus primarily on poetry and explore many different types of poems such as sense, acrostic and haiku.

Health & Wellbeing

PE - In PE this term we will be developing our skills in badminton. Through these sessions we work both individually and in partnerships to learn new shots and in turn improve communication.

Health and Wellbeing -

We will be exploring food groups, identifying taste, textures and where our food comes from. We will also start to look at the use of medicines and substances and making safe choices to positively impact our health and wellbeing.

Compliment cards will to be shared regularly to celebrate pupils individuality through PATHS Pupil of the Day.


Numeracy & Mathematics

This term we will be focussing on addition, subtraction and multiplication. We will continue to work on our number talks strategies to solve calculations – paying particular attention to partitioning, add up and removal for subtraction. We will build upon our previous knowledge of multiplication using strategies such as arrays, equal groups and repeated addition.

Towards the end of the term, we will also explore symmetry and shape through a range of winter and festive activities.

Interdisciplinary Learning

As we begin this term, we will be finishing off our much loved London topic by looking at transport and comparing the city to our local community.



In science, we will be exploring electricity and how electrical circuits work. Latterly, we will be learning more about inheritance and our genetics.
