### Language & Literacy

We will continue learning one new phoneme each week with one common word. We now have lots of sounds which help us to blend and write many different words.

Reading books will continue to be given out each week and comprehension tasks are completed in class.



We will continue learning how to write complete sentences with capital letters, finger spaces and full stops through many different writing activities. We will begin adding some connective words to extend our sentences.

### Numeracy & Mathematics

- We will be introducing time. We will focus on telling the time to the o'clock on both analogue and digital clocks as well as linking time to key parts of our daily routines. We will be working hard to order the days of the week and the months of the year.
- Measurement will be explored by considering height, weight and volume. We will explore simple units of measurement as well as finding our own ways to measure. We will be comparing objects and using mathematical terms to describe the differences.
- We will be continuing to expose the children to addition and subtraction calculations every week to consolidate our term 2 and 3 learning.

### Health & Wellbeing

P.E- A block of hockey skills will be completed before we focus on athletics. This will see us learning how to run, jump and throw in preparation for our sports day.

Health - We will continue to use Barnardo's PATHS programme of work to support pupils to explore and develop their understanding of regulating their emotions.

This term we will complete our relationships, sexual health and parenting learning in line with the East Ayrshire Early Level guidance. (<https://rshp.scot/early-level/>)

### Contexts for Learning

Our context for learning this term will be Dinosaurs. We will be researching to create fact files as well as incubating our own dinosaur eggs. We will be using our context for learning to support imaginative play and story writing.
