Happy New Year! We hope you have all enjoyed a restful holiday and are ready for an exciting year ahead. We have lots to look forward to in the coming term from World Book Day to Burns celebrations. The children thoroughly enjoyed diving into our science topic 'The Human Body' last term and are excited to embark on our Project Based Learning this term. Thank you for your continued support and here's to another fantastic term!

### Language & Literacy

This term we will be continuing with stage 3 of our Active Literacy spelling programme. Reading skills will continue to be enhanced through non-fiction texts as the children participate in Project Based Learning. Reading comprehension this term will be based around our class novel 'The Twits'. Our writing focus will be narrative texts, including imaginative stories inspired by our current learning. Children will continue to be given reading books alongside our new sound and common words which will be posted on Learning Journals each week.



### Health & Wellbeing



**PE** – This term we will be moving onto gymnastics where we will be working on our balance, strength and coordination.

**Health** – The children will continue to learn about feelings and coping with emotions through our PATHS programme. They will also be learning about online safety, similarity, diversity and respect.

### Numeracy & Mathematics

In numeracy, we will be focussing on our multiplication and division skills and will also be learning about fractions.



We will be introducing multiplication monsters where learners have the opportunity to win rewards for knowing their times tables, any support with practising multiplication facts at home is welcomed. The children continue to have access to Sumdog which we would encourage use of at home.

### Contexts for Learning

We will be participating in a Project Based Learning approach to interdisciplinary learning where the focus will be helping pupils to develop higher order thinking, creativity, analysis, critical thinking and problem-solving skills. This will provide opportunities for exciting STEM challenges and expressive arts. Our ICT focus will be on continuing to use our log in and passwords for glow & exploring basic Microsoft packages.

We will be learning about French food, developing our British Sign Language skills focussed on questioning and emotions and exploring the Valentine's Day and Easter stories in RME.
