S Grow your own mini garden meadow





You will need:

· Spare patch of the garden



an area that hasn't had fertiliser or compost added

· Packet of meadow flower seeds




· Grass seed





· Rake



· Twiggy branches



Remove grass, weeds and the top layer of soil, then lightly rake.



Mix together I part wildflower seed with 4 parts grass seed and some sand.



this will help you see where you're sowing

Sprinkle your seed mix in spring or autumn.

5q of seed per metre2 of soil



- Walk over the soil and water lightly.
- Arrange branches over your seeds to keep animals out.



Cut in summer to 5-10cm high and compost the cuttings.





Cornfield annuals will flower in the first year. Perennial meadows often need two years.
