EXA 2-02a</p> <p><u>Learning Outcome</u></p> <p>Pupils will learn to combine media and techniques to create a single piece of work.</p>	<p><u>Resources</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Single sheet of black card or sugar paper per pupil (minimum A4 size) per pupil • Selection of papers – sugar or copy no bigger than A4 size. • Selection of wax crayons in variety of colours • White (or other light bright colour to contrast with black paper) pencil per pupil. • Scissors.
<p><u>Activity</u></p> <p>Make a collage using cut outs from wax rubbings and detail added with pencil.</p> <p>Make a picture of clothes hanging on a washing line.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Using different coloured papers, pupils make wax rubbings from a variety of surfaces (e.g. brick, tarmac, tree trunks, drain covers). 2. Cut out shapes from the rubbings to represent clothes hangin on a washing line. 3. On the black paper, draw a washing line with white pencil. 4. Glue cut outs into place. 5. Add further details to the black paper using white pencil. <p>Alternative subjects for the collage – the school buildings, surrounding built environment, a subject linked to other current learning.</p>	<p><u>Assessment</u></p> <p>Photograph pupils' work.</p> <p>Have pupils used both media (pencil and cut outs).</p> <p>Have pupils combined them to create a single piece of work?</p> <div style="text-align: center;">  </div>
