Experience and Outcomes

Learning Outcome

Pupils learn that each of us can do tasks that benefit ourselves, friends, family and community.

Resources

- plug plants (e.g. pansies)
- pots
- compost
- crocks or stones to place in bottom of the pot
- watering can or upcycled plastic milk carton



<u>Activity</u> Planting spring bulbs or plug plants

- 1. Pupils are asked to help with making our outdoor space a nice one for people to visit.
- 2. Teacher shows pots and plants and explains that we will be planting up pots so that visitors and people who use our school get to see something nice when they arrive or are in our playground.
- 3. Teacher demonstrates planting and emphasises that plants are living things that need to be treated gently and must be looked after.
- 4. Once pupils have each planted up their pots, pots are placed at agreed locations and watered.
- 5. Pupils are told that they have been given the job of taking care of the plants and routine of watering and maintaining established.

<u>Assessment</u>

Can pupils describe how they think people will feel when they see the plants?

Can pupils suggest other ways that they could make people feel good about coming to our school?
