E&O: ENG 1-31a Having explored the elements which writers use in different genres, I can use what I learn to create my own stories, poems and plays with interesting structures, characters and/or settings. Learning Outcomes: Demonstrate understanding of nouns. Help to create a poem using nouns.	Resources Needed White board/notebook pens. Collect items on walk to area. Small tarp for kims game Poetry book Whiteboard and pen/Voice memo app
Activity Begin with Kims game — Name each item, use the word noun frequently. Remove one item from under the tarp and see if they can remember what it was. Read poem — What is Pink? ¹Ask pupils if they would like to write a poem that can be shared with other people like in the book? Create a poem — We went out on a walk and what did we see? Walk around the area, spot something, identify it, name it, describe it. Record the lines of the poem on whiteboard or voice app.	Assessment Return to class — use floor book to add new knowledge after asking the question in green. (See grid above). Further assessment — ask pupils to identify or write down a noun.
