Activity	Assessment
Begin with discussion of what you would find in the woods – Leaves, sticks,	Teacher to take pictures of art work created for display
trees, flowers, stones etc	Review of the art created, discussion with children on what they have used and
Show picture of art using nature to give example of what we aim to recreate.	why to understand their vision
Class split in to smaller groups of 2/3 and given a bucket to collect items.	Children to write about their art work to display alongside pictures
~15minutes allowed for this task.	
Pupils then create a woodland picture using the materials collected.	Further assessment – ask pupils to identify the trees and items in the woods
~20minutes	from the collected objects.
Discussion in the group of the pictures created and the materials used, talking	
about colours, textures and shapes ~10minutes	
Photographs taken of the pictures for display in the class.	
Items used for the art returned to nature. Selection taken back to class to use	
for creating prints.
