Decorations for Wildlife



Why not make your christmas decorations fun for animals as well? Here are some ideas on how to make edible ornaments which the wildlife around you will love!



Pine cone bird feeders:

What will you need: pine cone, peanut butter, bird seed, string

How to make it: 1. Cut string and tie to end of pine cone

- 2. Cover your pine cone completely in peanut butter
- 3. Roll your pine in the bird seed
- 4. Hang outside for birds and squirrels to feast on!

Orange Bird Feeders:

- What you will need: 1 orange (you can eat the other half), 1 cup of bird seed (or a mix of sunflowers seeds, peanuts and dried fruit),
 100g of lard or vegetable fat, string
- How to make it: 1. Cut your orange in half and scoop out the centre
- 2. Roll your lard into a ball which will fit in your orange skin
- 3. Roll the ball of lard in bird seed and push your seeded ball into the orange skin
- 4. Get 2 bamboo skewers and push them through the orange so they stick out the other side. They should make a criss cross shape.
- 5. Tie string around the four skewer ends so you can hang your bird feeder on a tree outside!
