In Primary 1, we encourage the children to have a go! Below are activities which your child could have a go, when at home this month.

Literacy

These are the phonemes we will be working on this month. Have a go at practising them at home. 😊



r Pretend to be a puppy holding a rag, shaking head from side to side and say *rrrrrrrrrr*.



m Rub tummy as if seeing tasty food and say *mmmmm*.



d Beat hands up and down as if playing a drum and say *d, d, d, d*.



e Pretend to tap an egg on the side of a pan and crack it into the pan, saying *eh, eh, eh*.



c Raise hands and snap fingers as if playing castanets and say *ck, ck, ck*.



k Raise hands and sway them side to side like a kite flying and say *k, k, k..*

Caterpillar ordering & sequencing (forwards & backwards) - Topmarks
Select sequencing either 1 to 10 or 10 to 1 from menu for your child.
