In Primary 1, we encourage the children to have a go! Below are activities which your child could have a go, when at home this month.

Literacy

These are the phonemes we will be working on this month. Have a go at practising them at home.



s Weave hand in an s shape, like a snake, and say *ssssss*.



a Wiggle fingers above elbow as if ants crawling on you, saying *a, a, a*.



t Turn head from side to side as if watching tennis and say *t, t, t, t*.



i Pretend to be a mouse by wiggling fingers at end of noise and squeak *i, i, i, i*.



p Pretend to puff out candles and say *p, p, p*.



n Hold arms out at side, as if a plane, and say *nnnnnnnnnn*.
